
**Subject: Implementation of Comprehensive Guidelines for Basic Education Budget and Work Planning in Kogi State.**

1. Towards improving basic education planning and budgeting in Kogi State, it is my pleasure to formally communicate the approval of a Comprehensive Guidelines for Basic Education Budget and Work Planning in Kogi State for immediate implementation by all Departments, Agencies, Boards and Commissions under the Kogi State Education Sector.

These guidelines have been developed by the Ministry of Education in collaboration with the Ministry of Budget and Economic Planning to standardize, consolidate, and enhance the efficiency, transparency, and strategic alignment of basic education budget and work planning processes across the education sector MDAs.

In line with the above, all MDAs under the education sector are hereby directed to adhere to the Guidelines from now henceforth and prepare their annual MDA workplans and budgets for basic education activities strictly in accordance with the procedures in the guidelines. All MDAs must also ensure all activities and projects are fully prioritized, costed, justified, and aligned with basic education development priorities of Kogi State detailed in the Medium Term Education Sector Strategy, Strategic Education Policy/Plan and the 10-year Development Agenda for Kogi State (DEVAGOM).
