

On this note, for several years the Kogi State Broadcasting Corporation FM 94 had experienced inadequate power supply and this had made the radio station less effective and less efficient.

Within One Hundred Days in

office, His Excellency, Alhaji Ahmed Usman Ododo in his magnanimity has taken bold steps to put an end to the inadequate power supply in the Radio Station by providing hybrid power which comprises of solar power and the installation of the 33 KVA transformer to link up the line for daily 24 hours power supply. This has steered a massive revolution in the broadcasting industry as this development would enable the radio station to operate for at least 20 hours per day.

This increase in the number of broadcasting hours has also led to increase in the need for manpower which requires recruitment of more staff. This has in turn reduced the number of unemployment in the state as it is an avenue of creating job opportunities.

Radio is one of the easiest, fastest and cheapest means of disseminating information to heterogeneous audience. And at the same time it reaches the Grassroots, both literates and uneducated ones. This initiative aims to mitigate the impact of the economic challenges on the residents of Kogi State. As a result of these adjustments, residents can expect to see more affordable prices on essential goods and services in the local markets. - **2.** An ongoing project involves the installation of 3 No 2.5 MVA. 33/0.415 KV transformers and the extension of a 33KV O-H line from Okene transmission substation to Confluence University of Science and Technology in Osara, Kogi State. As part of the infrastructure development plan for the State, these projects aim to improve the power supply to key institutions and communities in Kogi State. The installation of the transformers and extension of the transmission lines will not only enhance the reliability of electricity supply but also support the growth and development of Confluence University of Science and Technology and the various institutions in the area. With these upgrades, the region is poised to experience increased efficiency and productivity in its power distribution network.
- Another ongoing project 3. includes the extension of the 33KV CBN feeder to various ministries and the installation of 1 No. 500KVA 33/0.415KV, 1 No. 300KVA 33/0.415KV, 2 No. 200KVA 33/415KV, and 2 No. 10KVA 33/0.415KV transformers to 12 MDA's in Lokoja, Kogi State. Upon completion of the installation of the transformers to the 12 MDA's in Lokoja, Kogi State, the power supply to these

government agencies will be significantly improved. This upgrade will not only enhance the efficiency of operations within the MDA's but also contribute to the overall development of the state. The increased capacity provided by the transformers will support the growing energy demands of the region, paving the way for further infrastructure projects like the extension of the 33KV line and lowtension network.

Additionally, an ongoing project involves the extension of a 33KV line. installation, and reticulation of a low-tension network that feeds the State House of Assembly complex and the surrounding communities. The Provost, Obangede College of Nursing and Midwifery, Dr. Mrs. Hannah Abraham Oziohu has lauded the Kogi State Government for the recent upgrade of the institution from School to College.

In an exclusive interview with Information Officers of the Ministry of Information and Communications, the Provost commended the efforts of the state government in terms of infrastructure, renovation of existing structures, erection of more structures, fencing as well as the establishment of exit gate in the College. The College, established in 1980 has made significance progress since the provost took over due to the pragmatic efforts of successive government.

"Since I took over as the Provost in March 2017, there has been several progresses in the college, starting from the improvement of infrastructure, human resources, coupled with the upgrade to college status. The College has existed since 1980", she emphasized.

She expressed satisfaction that the College can now award Higher National Diploma (HND) certificate and professional certificate like every other institution in the state and country at large.

"It is only the college of nursing that still operates a professional institution, but few years ago it was decided that the profession needed to flow into the regular educational system of the country. Since then, schools of nursing were told to a ffiliate with Universities or go for NBT accreditation.

But there was no Institution that had started nursing as at then, so the College

could not affiliate with institutions that were not accredited, but the College has decided to go for NBT accreditation. This year, the college will admit the second set. But before accreditation, you must have infrastructures. The NBT has assessed the college and has given it accreditation, hence it has been upgraded from a School to a College", the Provost observed.



Despite the recent progress, Dr. Oziohu expressed urgent concern about the stalled bridge construction project in Obangede. The incomplete bridge threatens to isolate the college, especially during the rainy season.

The Provost, however, urgently appealed to the state government to take immediate action on the



bridge construction that was abruptly halted after a mishap in Obangede community.

She pleaded with the authorities to resume work on the bridge to prevent the college from being cut off, while emphasizing that the raining season could pose a serious threat by isolating the college, reducing admission rates, hindering the activities of staff and students, as well as preventing student nurses from accessing their practical facilities.

"I am pleading to the government to please see to the bridge so that the college will not be cut off. If the road is not completed, our admission will be reduced, and our students will not be able to go for their practical. I know they were working on it before the mishap happened, but my appeal is that they should expedite action because when the rain starts in earnest, it will cut off the College. This is my major appeal, " the Provost said.

In the same vein, the Provost requested the state government's support in providing more sources of water for the college. She highlighted the importance of adequate water supply for the daily activities of the institution and its inhabitants. Furthermore, she stressed the need for more hostels to accommodate the growing population of students.

"This measure would alleviate the hardship faced by students who currently have to venture outside the college premises to obtain water for their needs", she noted.

Also adding his voice, the President of the Student Union Government (SUG), of the College, Comrade Abdul Malik Ibrahim, while appreciating the Provost and the government for their immense contributions to the College's welfare, also joined in advocating for more hostels to alleviate the living conditions of the students.

The representatives of the SUG emphasized the necessity of reducing the students' hardships, particularly in relation to obtaining water.

They pointed out that having more hostels on campus, more classrooms and lecture theatres would not only provide convenient access to facilities but also foster a sense of community and security.

Additionally, the SUG requested the provision of more buses to

facilitate transportation to the students' practical centers, ensuring easy accessibility for all.

Similarly, a cross section of student nurses also voiced their dissatisfaction with the insufficient water supplies, hostel facilities, and security issues within their college.


They believe that these problems have significantly hindered their learning experiences in various ways.

"To obtain portable water for daily use, we must travel miles as the on-campus water supply is unable to cater to everyone's needs", they posited.

Can we meet you?

Greetings, I am Professor Solomon Avidime, a distinguished Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and currently serving as the Chief Medical Director of Central Reference Hospital in Okene. Prior to my appointment here, I was a faculty member at Ahmadu Bello University in Zaria. It has been seven months since we began operations at this esteemed institution, and I am honored to lead such a dedicated team of healthcare professionals.

Can you give us a brief overview of this Central Reference Hospital Okene?

The Central Reference Hospital Okene stands as a remarkable achievement, brought to fruition under the visionary leadership of the former Governor of Kogi State, His Excellency Alh. Dr. Yahaya Adoza Bello. This project represents a significant investment by the Kogi State Government in healthcare, boasting a meticulously designed exterior and interior, encompassing three floors and approximately 250 bed spaces.

Within the hospital, a multitude

of Clinical Departments and laboratory medicine facilities are housed. These Clinical Departments include Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Surgery, Paediatrics, and Medicine, each meticulously delineated to ensure optimal patient care. Additionally, the hospital features an Eye Care Department and a state-of-theart Radio diagnostic Centre, equipped with cutting-edge technology previously unseen in Nigeria and much of Africa.

Furthermore, the hospital is equipped with an Emergency Department, boasting four theatres including specialized facilities for general surgery, emergency procedures, and labour ward operations. A Dialysis Centre, equipped with specialized machines, further enhances the hospital's capabilities, all of which adhere to international standards of excellence.

What is the Staff Strength of this hospital?

Upon visiting our analysis centre, you will encounter the latest



models of diagnostic equipment that are not easily found elsewhere. Our theatre is equipped with modern amenities, including advanced lighting, precision instruments, operating microscopes, and state-of-the-art operating tables.

Our commitment to excellence is not merely a marketing campaign - it is a tangible reality. The investments we have made in our facilities are evident in the advanced technologies we utilize to provide top-notch care to our patients.

What is Proficiency of the staff handling the equipment?

Adjacent to the oxygen plant is our hyperbaric oxygen treatment facility, the first of its kind in Nigeria. This facility is reserved for special patients who require treatment with pure oxygen. We are in the process of activating this facility and expect to begin offering services soon.

Since opening our doors seven months ago, we have been providing immediate healthcare services to the community. We are gradually expanding our services to include specialized care, such as our intensive care unit for patients requiring intensive care management.

We are grateful for the support of His Excellency Alh. Ahmed Usman Ododo, the Executive Governor of the State, and the Health Ministry, who oversee our activities. Their support has been instrumental in our success thus far.

With the establishment of this hospital. Can it stem medical

tourism?

Our state-of-the-art facility is designed to cater to the needs of international patients, offering executive rooms for their comfort and convenience. Our ambulances are equipped with modern amenities, including oxygen, and trained medical staff, ensuring that patients can be transported safely and efficiently throughout Nigeria.

We are already providing these services and are working towards expanding our reach to attract patients from outside Nigeria to Okene for their medical needs. With our commitment to excellence and patient care, we are confident that Okene will soon be recognized as a hub for medical tourism on a global scale.

- 3. Improve perimeter security with fencing, barbed wire, and secure gates both at the front and the back of the school

- 11. Build a Security Tower

Kogi Election Tribunal Verdict: Why Muritala Ajaka of SDP Lost



he Kogi Electoral Tribunal in Abuja delivered its verdict on May 27, 2024, confirming the incumbent Governor, Alhaji Usman Ododo, as the rightful winner of the November 11,2023 Kogi Elections.

The petitioner, Alhaji Muritala Ajaka of the Social Democratic Party, failed to prove his case, which centred around alleged noncompliance with the 2022 Electoral Act. The tribunal judge emphasized that Section 137 of the Electoral Act is not a cure-all solution. Various accusations were made against Alhaji Usman Ododo by the petitioners, including claims of over-voting and certificate forgery, with the hope of overturning the election results in their favour.

In the court's ruling, it was stated that:

•The allegations of over-voting were dismissed due to lack of concrete evidence. The judge noted

that the petitioners could not prove that the Respondent was involved in any fraudulent activities. Additionally, the witnesses provided conflicting testimonies compared to their written statements. The court also highlighted that the petitioners failed to present witnesses from all polling units, casting doubt on the credibility of those who did testify.

The petitioners' failure to provide substantial witnesses and video evidence weakened their case, as Section 137 of the Electoral Act cannot be used as a quick fix without proper supporting evidence. Overall, the tribunal's verdict favored Alhaji Usman Ododo, citing the lack of compelling evidence from the petitioners to support their claims.

•The Star witness of the SDP, who was alleged to be a staff of the Independent Electoral Commission, INEC, was not verified to be a staff of the electoral

umpire. His disposition during cross examination also shows he was not part and parcel of the election as he was out of station in Imo State on the day of Election in Kogi State.

The court also ruled that individuals who are not part of the manufacturing of the Bimodal Verification System, BVAS, lose the locus standi to demonstrate such evidence in exhibit.

•The Forensic Expert provided by the petitioners to substantiate their claims of

over-voting, following an inspection of the electoral materials, failed to meet the requirements set forth in the electoral act, as determined by the judges. The purported expert only submitted a photocopy of his credentials, which the Tribunal deemed insufficient to validate his professional expertise.

· Regarding the Certificate Forgery claims, the court ruled that the issue was essentially a moot point, as it fell under pre-election matters and was therefore time-barred.

The aforementioned reasons formed the basis for the dismissal of the SDP candidates' prayers, as they were found to lack merit and failed to establish beyond a reasonable doubt that they had won the election. Consequently, the Tribunal declared Alhaji Usman Ododo as the duly elected winner of the Kogi November 11th, 2023 elections.
